Jon Shelton is associate professor and chair of democracy and justice studies at UW-Green Bay. He is the author of *Teacher Strike! Public Education and the Making of a New American Political Order*, which was the winner, as a dissertation, of the Labor and Working-Class History Association's Herbert Gutman Prize for Best Dissertation in 2014, and the International Standing Conference of the History of Education's First Book Award in 2018. His new book, *The Rise and Fall of the Human Capital Myth*, is under contract with Cornell University Press. He sits on the Board of Directors for the Labor and Working-Class History Association and the Wisconsin Labor History Society, and is Vice-President for Higher Education of the American Federation of Teachers–Wisconsin.
